## SARAH POWELL HUNTINGTON HOUSE



WPA's Sarah Powell Huntington House (SPHH) is a 28-bed apartment-style shelter for women and children, providing families with temporary housing. When women come to SPHH, they receive on-site wraparound case management and support in finding long-term housing.

Families come to SPHH through the Department of Homeless Services (DHS)/PATH.

### Wraparound Case Management

Using a model of care designed for women, our team works collaboratively with every client to create individualized service plans, identifying their immediate needs and long-term goals; additionally, staff help families find safe, permanent housing.

### Community- Based Services

To build stability, we provide referrals to WPA programs that clients may be eligible for and to off-site services, providing support for emergency assistance, benefits, continuing education, job readiness training, and school-related advocacy for children and families.

### Clinical Services

Using trauma-informed practices, staff provide clients with mental health counseling, empowering them to strengthen self-compassion and resilience.
